Horse & Rider Requirements

Horses brought to the CHA Region 10 Conference must be healthy, sound and suitable for use in a group riding situation. All riders must wear a sleeved shirt, long pants or breeches, riding boots, and an **ASTM/SEI approved riding helmet**. No tank tops, halter tops, shorts, Capri pants, "Fat Baby Boots" or hiking boots allowed. All riders must be at least 10 years old and capable of controlling their horse on the ground at walk and trot and mounted at a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope. All riders must sign a liability release prior to bringing their horse onto CRK Training Stable property. Minors must have the release signed by a parent or guardian. All horses must be ridden with a saddle and bridle. No bareback riders or horses ridden with halters. Bitless bridles OK.

Vaccination records for each horse must be delivered with registration forms in order for registration to be accepted. Records must be from a Licensed Veterinarian and list the name, age, breed and description of the horse. Records must show that within the past year the horse was vaccinated for: Western Equine Encephalitis, Eastern Equine Encephalitis, and Tetanus. AND within the past 6 months Rhinopneumonitis, Influenza, and West Nile. Only Veterinarian Records will be accepted. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Horses will be provided with a fully covered pipe stall. Alfalfa hay (1 flake) will be fed Sunday AM & PM. Stalls will be available after 6:00 PM on Saturday 9/24 and must be vacated no later than 8:00 pm Sunday or you will be charged for additional days. A \$10.00 cleaning deposit must be included with the reservation. This will be refunded in cash upon return of the stall clean, undamaged and empty. Extra hay is available at \$2.00 per flake. No shavings or straw allowed. Please bring your own water buckets, tack, and feed if needed. Tack rooms may be available. Please provide a lock and tack racks.

Due to space limitations, no horses may be trailered in on 9/25/11. All horses must be on the grounds by 8:30 PM Saturday 9/24/11. Horses may not be removed from the grounds until after 6:00 PM 9/25/11. **NO REFUNDS OF ANY FEES ONCE YOUR RESERVATION IS MADE! NO EXCEPTIONS! NO DOGS!**
